DRIVE THRU? THINK IT THROUGH.

Do your banking and place your to go orders inside. Idling cars create exhaust and waste gas.

SHARE A RIDE.

Carpooling or riding Citilink makes better use of fossil fuels while cutting the amount of gasses released into the air.

LIGHT THE WAY.

Replace standard filament bulbs with energy-efficient CFL-type bulbs. You'll use less electricity and save money.
